Franklin Square Civilian Patrol is an organization established about 20 years ago, with cumulative efforts of concerned citizens of Franklin Square. The force consists of about 45 members (currently) whom are broken into teams; each team is headed by a captain. We use modern technology including two-way radios (we also have our own repeater tower) as well as cell phones to communicate.

We patrol the Franklin Square neighborhood at various times of the day, especially side and dead-end streets, using marked and unmarked vehicles.

We work in tandem with the 5th Pct and have a well established relationship with them; fueled by mutual respect and understanding of each other's roles in the community, and we often work the major events in the neighborhood shoulder to shoulder.

Our members have the skills to handle various kinds of emergencies, either by themselves or through available resources. The continuing education and training that our members get help keeping our knowledge us up-to-date and continues to drive the self-motivation.

We are a non profit organization, our members enjoy volunteering their time and effort to make Franklin Square a safe home for all of us.
